Dear Parent/Carer,

As a link to our 'Moore and More' art topic, we will be visiting the Yorkshire Sculpture Park on Wednesday 8th February. This will be a full day trip, leaving school at 9:15am and returning at 3pm. Children will need to arrive at school and be collected at the usual time. This trip will entail a full tour of the park with an artist, as well as sculpture workshops (these will be run by the artist).

Your child will require a packed lunch and a drink (no cans or glass bottles). If you would like your child to take a packed lunch provided by the school, then please indicate on the return slip below.

Because we will be outside for some of the day, it is crucial that your child wears the appropriate clothing (see information below).

Footwear:

Sturdy footwear such as walking boots, wellies or trainers must be worn. Shoes should have no cut outs. No canvas pumps or Ugg type boots should be worn as these have no support or grip. Wear shoes that will stay warm and dry in wet and muddy conditions.

Clothing:

Children will need to wear their school uniform. Due to us being outside, please ensure your child has a coat, a warm jumper, scarf, hat and gloves.

School is subsidising our visit to keep the cost as low as possible. If you wish for your child to take part in this visit, please pay the voluntary contribution of £10.00 using Parent Pay no later than Friday 3rd February.
