Dear parents/carers,


As FS2 children are growing in confidence and now have a good understanding of the daily routine in their classrooms, we would like to work on increasing their independence on arriving at school in the mornings. Therefore, from Monday 27th January, school is asking that children start to line up as a class outside their classroom door. This is something we have already practised many times during the school day when moving from outdoor to indoor play.

The gate to foundation stage outdoor area will be unlocked at 8:45am for children to be "in the line for 10 to 9" as all other year groups do. Class teachers will greet children on the door and support them in hanging coats and bags in the cloakroom. Staff will be available in both classrooms to assist children in making their lunch choices before they complete their morning job in time for register at 9am.

We politely ask that parents/carers say their goodbyes as children join their line and that, unless urgent, parents see class teachers with any queries at home time to allow us to focus on welcoming the children. I hope you will agree that this will provide a calm and focused start to the day for all our children.

We appreciate your support while we implement this change and look forward to seeing just how independent the children can be.
